FAFSA

Assembly Bill 469/ CA Ed. Code 51225.7

- ▶ Legislation requiring high school seniors complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or California Dream Act (CADAA) for financial aid before graduating high school.
- ▶ California joined 7 other states to implement this Universal FAFSA policy
- ▶ families can opt-out by filling out a form

Why fill out the FAFSA?

- ▷ Post-secondary education is expensive
- ▷ In 2021, nearly \$3.75 billion in Pell Grants were unclaimed
 - ▶ Most from California = >\$500 million
 - ▶ Awarded to students on state-by-state basis to undergrads with exceptional financial need
- ▷ In 2021, only 54% of graduating seniors completed the FAFSA (↓ from 61% in 2017)
- ▷ No application = no money
- ▷ Even if you don't think you'll qualify, you might.

FAFSA At-A-Glance

- ▶ **Application Opens: October 1st of every year**
- ▶ **Priority Deadline March 2 of every year**
- ▶ Takes about 30 minutes to complete
 - ▶ More streamlined this year
- ▶ To apply visit studentaid.gov
 - ▶ First you will create an FSA ID
 - ▶ Next, gather necessary paperwork from parents & students (tax returns)
 - ▶ Fill out the FAFSA online

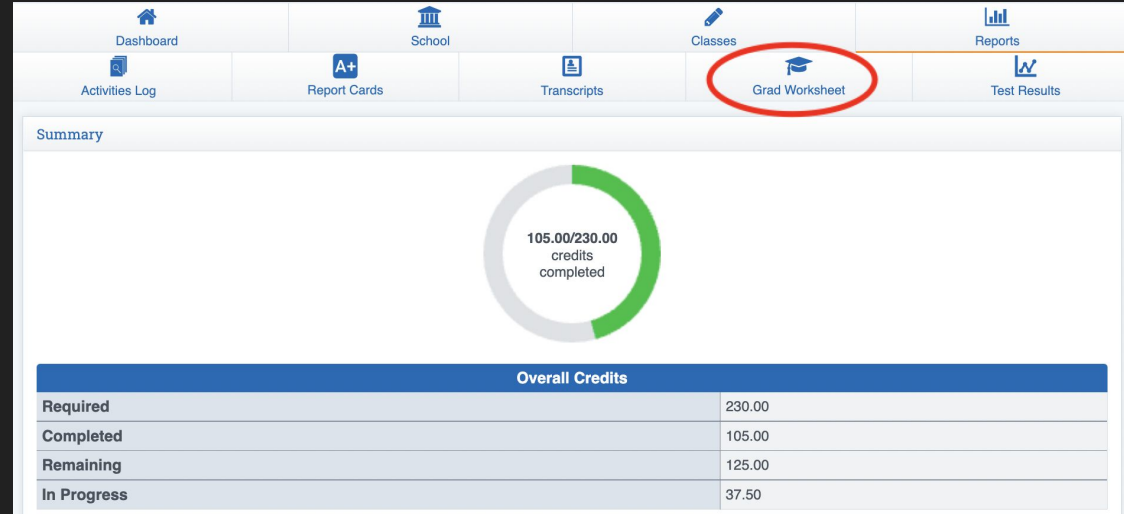

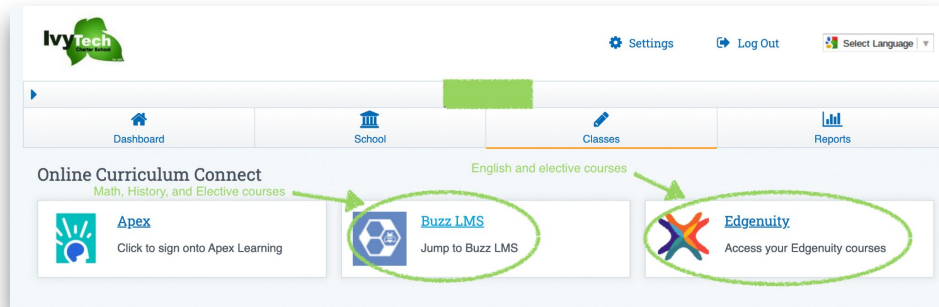

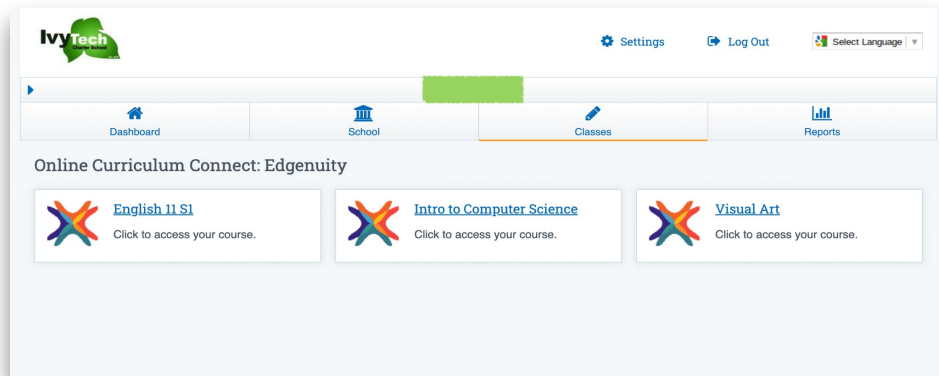

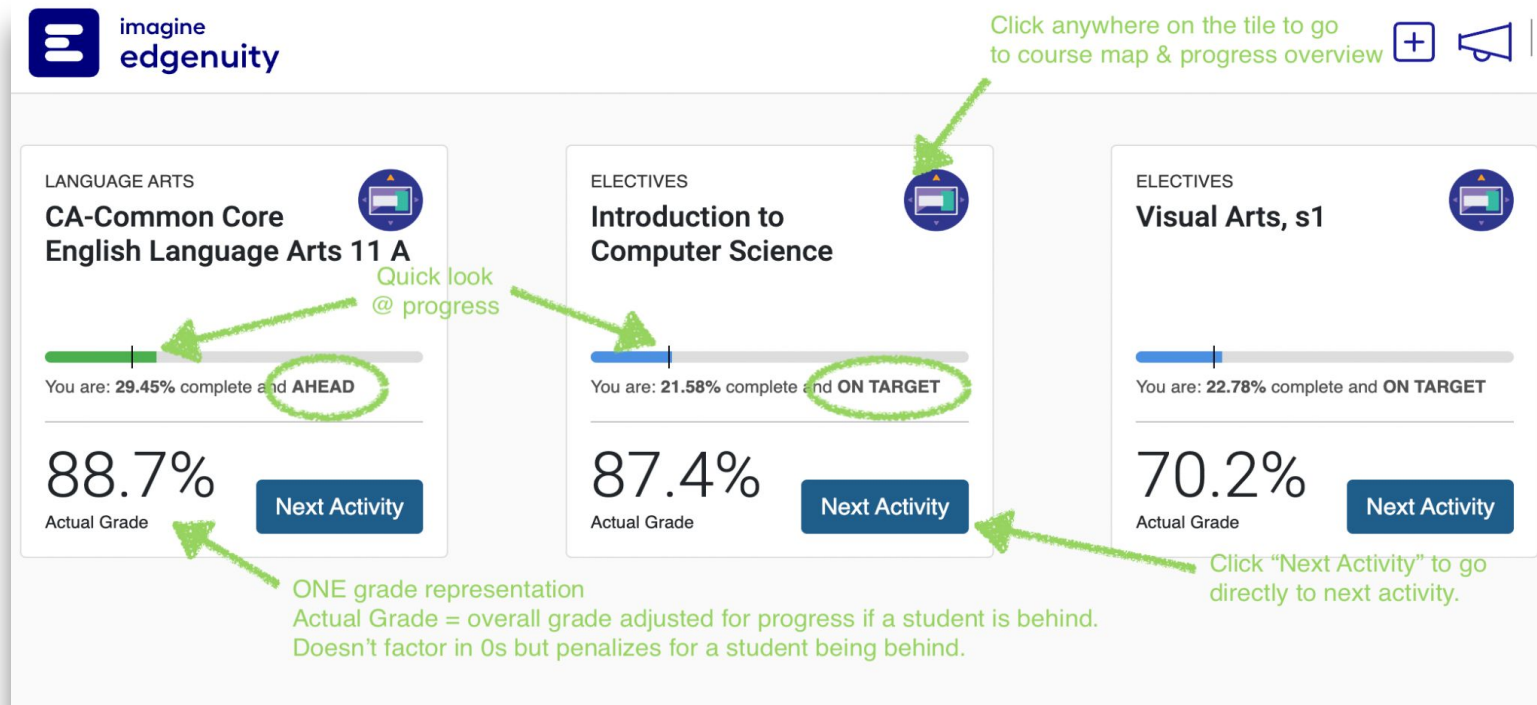


After selecting Edgenuity, students will be prompted to click on the course in which they are enrolled in Edgenuity.

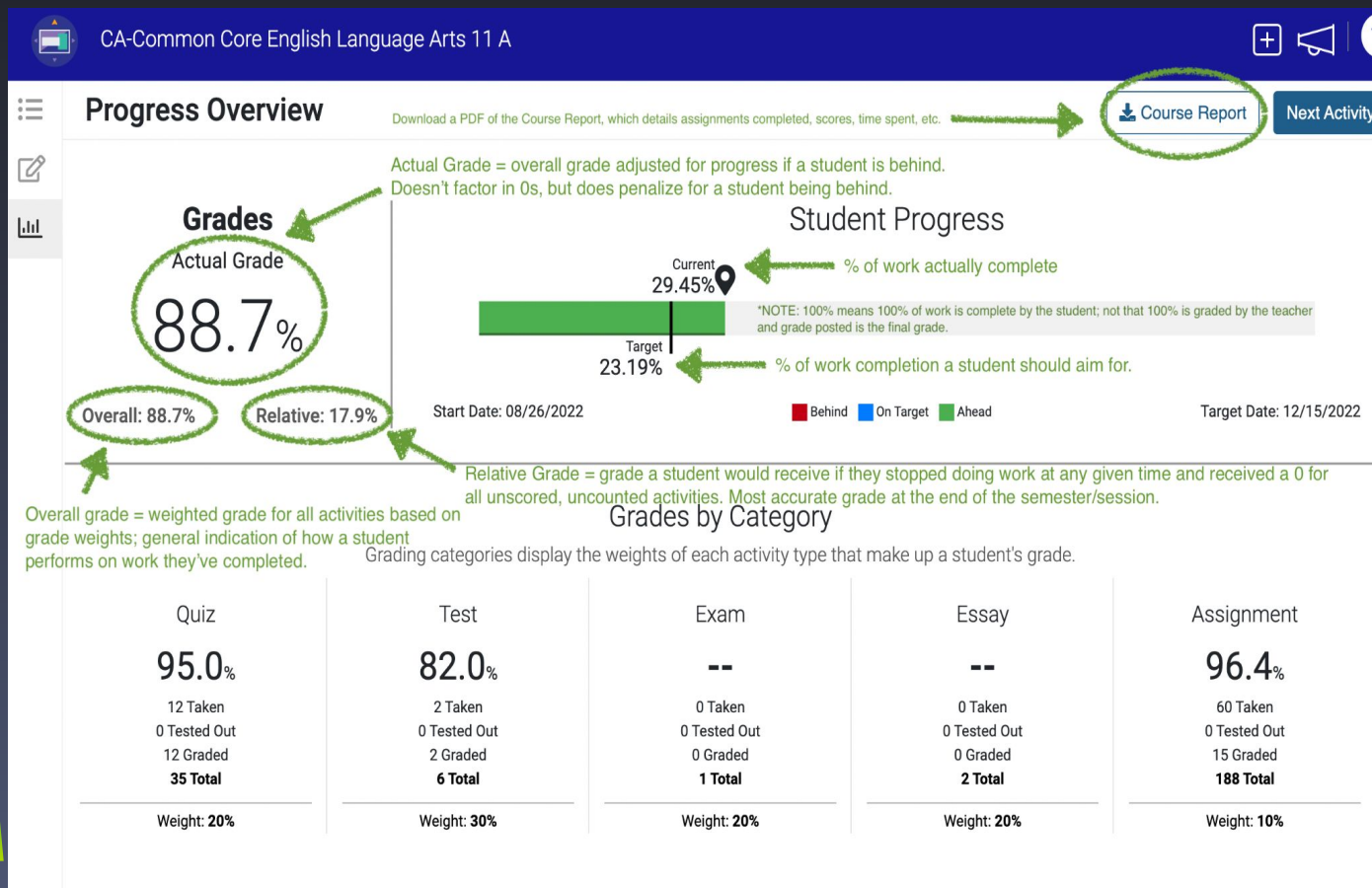

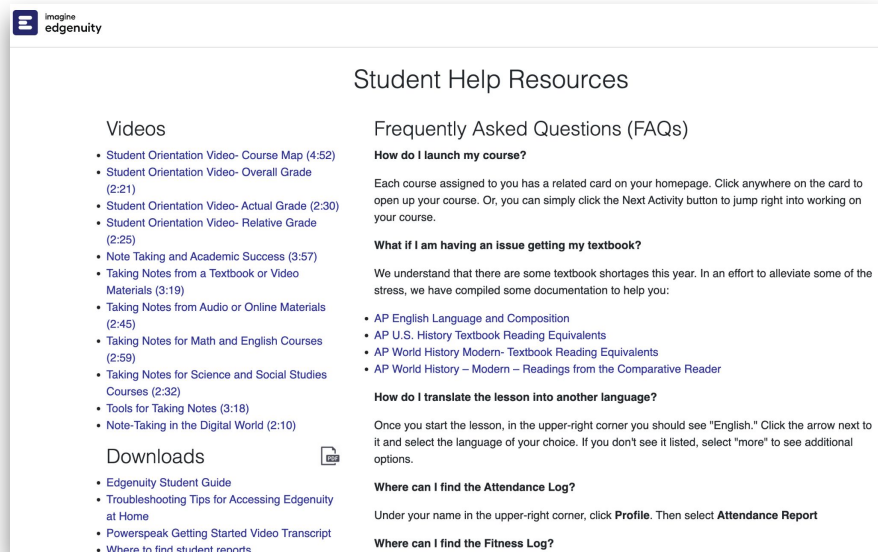
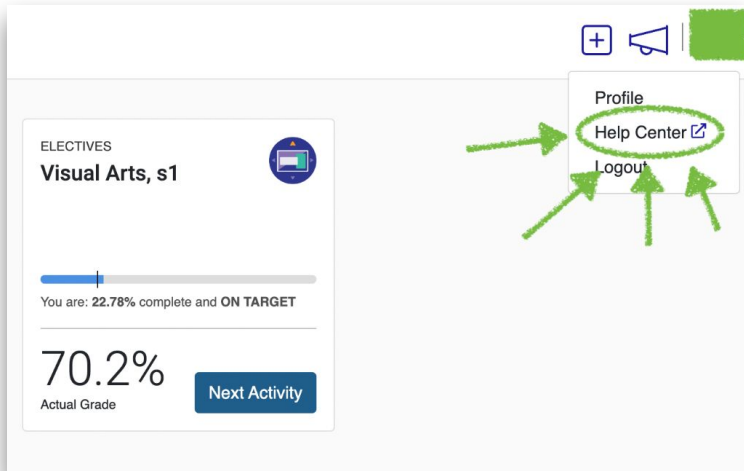
